Saint-Aubin

Bourgogne Hautes-Côtes de Beaune

The vines were planted in Saint-Aubin in the 1980s on 2 types of soil (one on white clay-limestone soil, and the other on a thin layer of red soil on lavas) which give all the complexity to this wine.

After being handpicked, the harvest is lightly crushed then pressed in a pneumatic press. . The juice is then allowed to settle and placed by gravity in French oak barrels to ferment with indigenous yeasts. After aging in barrels for 10 months, the wine is placed in vat for a month and is bottled at the estate.

This Hautes-Côtes-de-Beaune is elegant and well-structured with a lovely freshness. It would be beautifully paired as an aperitif or with seafood.
