

JÉRÔME FORNEROT

Saint-Aubin

Santenay Les Charrons

Planted in the 2000s under the Trois Croix hill, and alongside the Saint-Jean-de-Narosses church (13th century), this hillside plot faces south/south-west. It is located on stony clay-limestone soil. Sustainably grown, the vines are pruned in Guyot Poussard.

After being handpicked, the harvest is lightly crushed then pressed in a pneumatic press. . The juice is then allowed to settle and placed by gravity in French oak barrels to ferment with indigenous yeasts. After aging in barrels for 15 months (15% of new oak barrels), the wine is placed in vat for 3 months and is bottled at the estate.

This young plot gives beautiful white wines, with floral aromas, a fresh and tonic mouth. This white wine is perfect paired with risotto.
